7. Publishes The Cordovan newsletter three times a year to keep members informed of community news.
8. Donates funds for scholarships for Claremont Secondary School students, and to non-profit groups such as, Cordova Bay 55 Plus Association, the Cordova Bay Co-op Preschool and local sports clubs.
9. Organizes events such as the all-candidates meeting during federal, provincial and municipal election campaigns.
10. Holds the annual Cordova Bay Day event each summer.
