- 1. Keeps our community informed on issues of importance to Cordova Bay by providing updates on major projects from transportation to development and community issues.
  - Maintains our website www.cbaca.ca, which provides links to useful resources.
  - Publishes *The Cordovan*, our community newsletter, twice a year.
  - Sends e-mail notifications to members on relevant issues and events in Saanich. Updates our community notice boards at Mattick's Farm and The Haro.
- 2. Monitors applications for zoning and development, tracks proposed developments, and advocates for our Cordova Bay community by providing input and feedback to the District of Saanich, the Mayor and Council, and relevant municipal and provincial organizations.
- 3. Campaigns for traffic safety improvements throughout the Cordova Bay community.
- 4. Advocates to improve active transportation infrastructure including traffic calming, lighted crosswalks, and safe pedestrian and cycling routes.
- 5. Advocates to improve access and facilities in our parks and on our beaches.
- 6. Advocates and provides support for protecting and enhancing Cordova Bay's unique natural features and ecosystems, and honouring Cordova Bay's Indigenous heritage.
- 7. Spearheads community improvements, such as interpretive signage, graffiti removal and public art.
- 8. Organizes community engagement opportunities such as Cordova Bay Day, speaker series, and all-candidates meetings.
- 9. Donates funds for scholarships for Claremont Secondary School students, and to non-profit groups such as Cordova Bay Elementary, Cordova Bay Co-op Preschool and local sports clubs.
